

**Now I hope this was Easy to Follow, BUT Make it even SIMPLER!!!**

**This is the pattern you must follow – make it simpler for you and every one you are talking to.**

Remember, you come in! You want be on two cases, you get 2 people and you want them to get on 2 cases. Teach them the Right Way You are now a Star.

Basically the pattern you want to develop is you want to have EVERYBODY get 2 people who can get 2 people. DUPLICATE your system. You got 2 people who got 2 people, now you want to have them get 2 people who get 2 people. And so on and so forth.

**NOW I hope you guys can have the vision and see where this can go!**

**Where 2 people share with 2 people and share again.**

**Now Guys this is your volume. AT ONE POINT YOU LOSE TRACK of who shares with who...but what you don't lose tack of is the POINTS!**

At one point you will have 10000 points here and 20000 points there...just because you have shared it with a few people at the beginning and they did the same thing Now you get 10% of 10000 – that \$1000.00 and on the other side the remaining points 10000 stay there...roll over.

SO AGAIN WHEN YOU SHARE WITH YOU FRIENDS, don't just forget about them, HELP THEM SHARE WITH THEIR FRIENDS. The more people you help the more successful you will be.
